"Windows on the Passion" **Next Sunday**

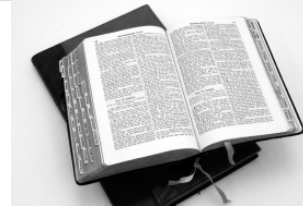

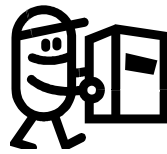
