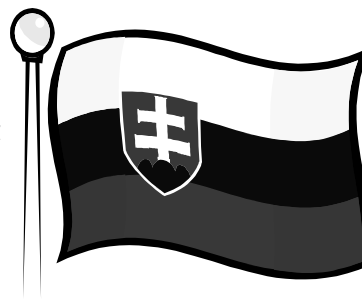

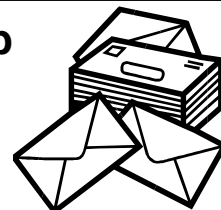

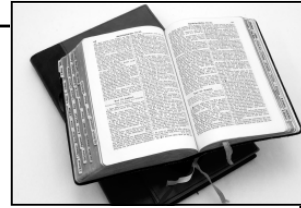
Men's Bible Study Group

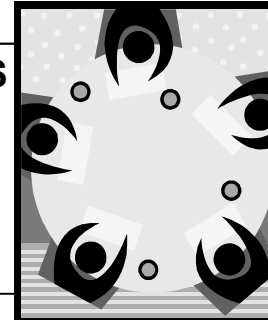
